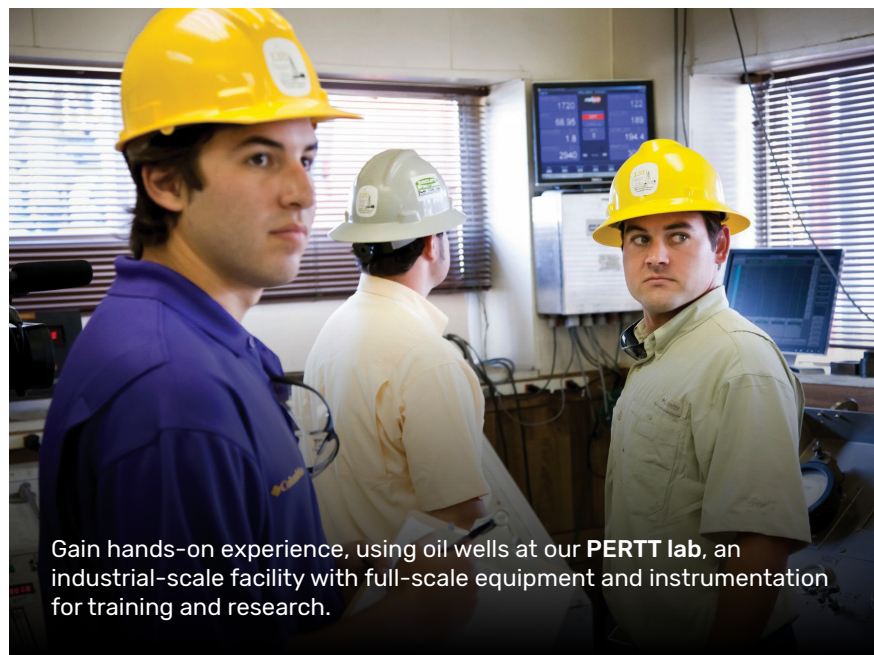

In recent years, no research team has been more significant than LSU’s Laser Interferometer Gravitational-Wave Observatory (LIGO) Scientific Coalition, who proved Einstein’s Theory of General Relativity.
