At the GE EPISCenter, Dayton researchers and students work side-by-side with GE Aviation scientists and engineers—a testament to what imagination and collaboration can accomplish.

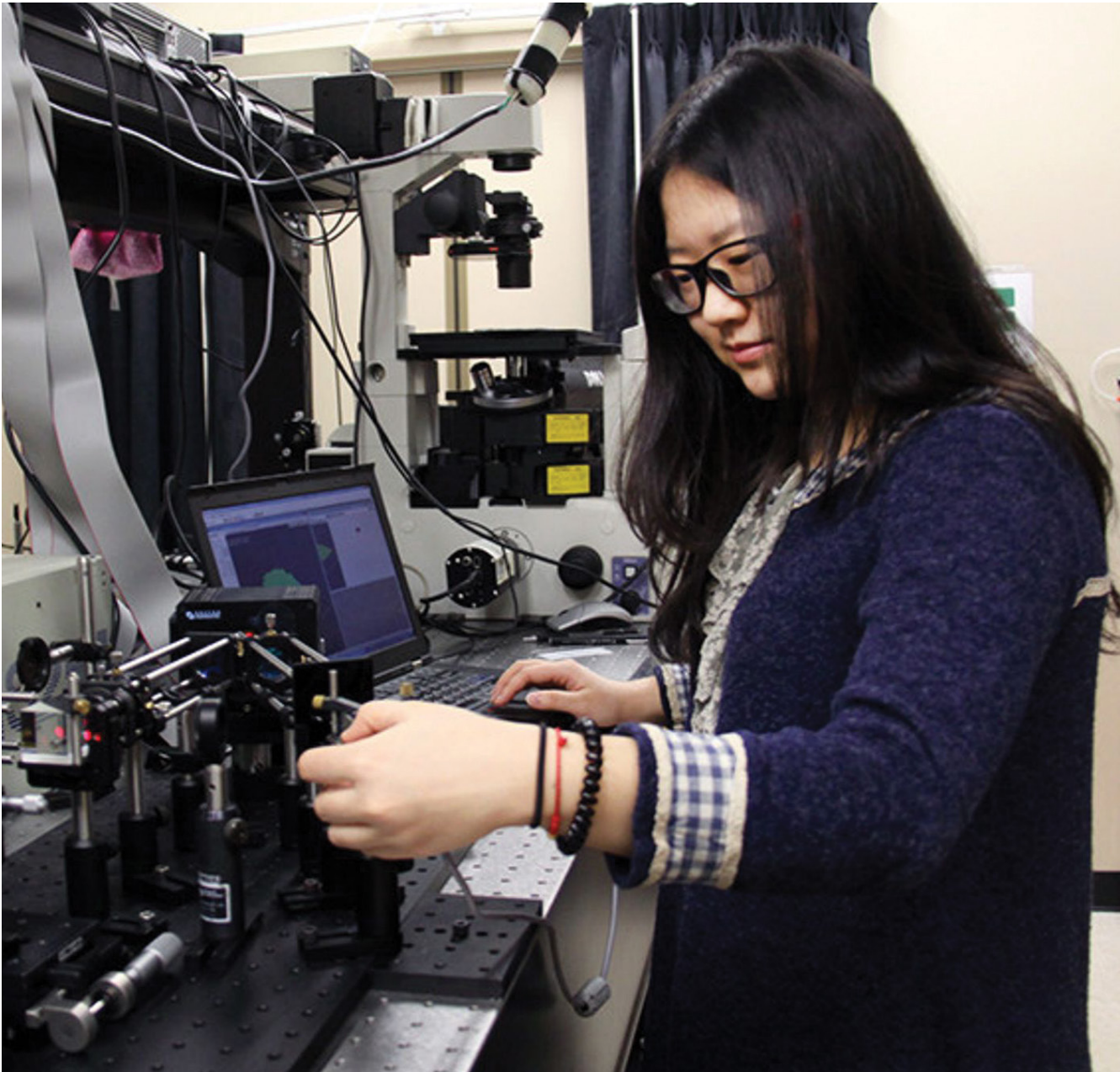

Transforming the World Through Innovation

University of Dayton researcher Tarek Taha has been a rising researcher in the artificial intelligence field for a decade. He hopes his third National Science Foundation award will help him develop a brain-inspired computer chip that can learn by itself and be more secure, efficient and compact than current chips. If successful, this new computer chip could provide the equivalent performance of an entire supercomputer, while consuming nearly one million times less energy.

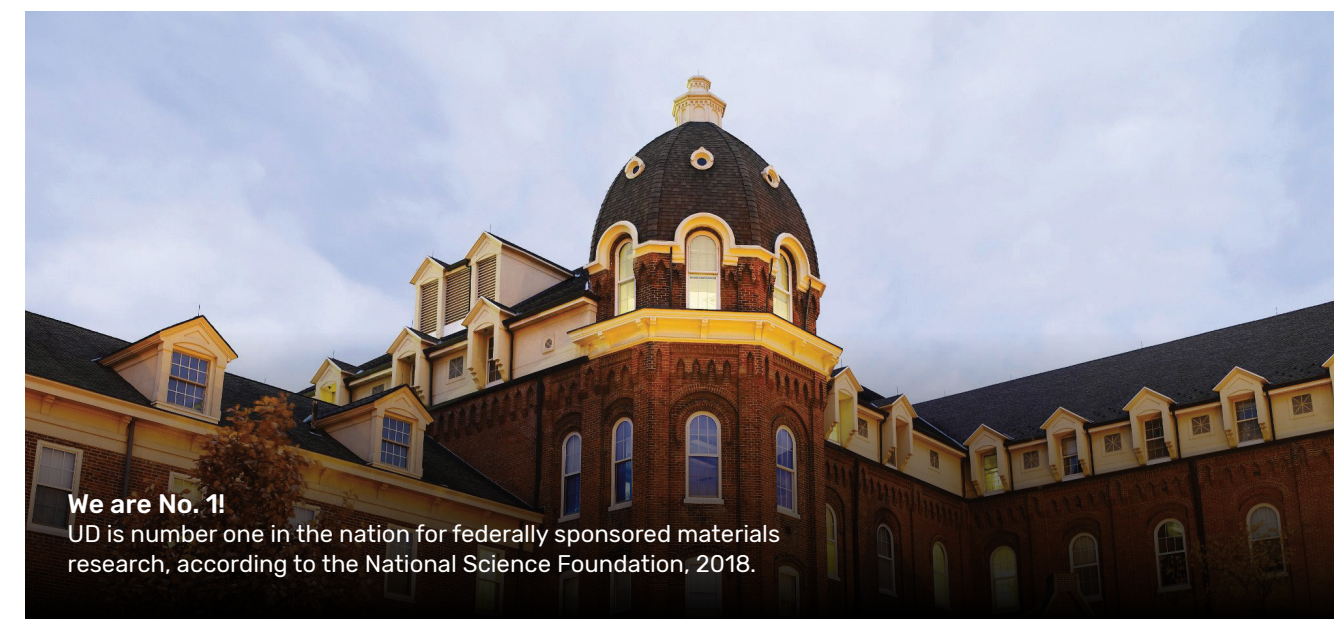
