At UMass Boston, you will work alongside world-class faculty and learn how our dedication to research, innovation, and creativity leads to vital contributions to the city of Boston, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and beyond. As an urban research university with a teaching soul, UMass Boston's fast-growing multidisciplinary approaches to research focus on the needs of our communities.

UMass Boston now leads the Boston Science Partnership (BSP), a teacher development program that focuses on improving science education in Boston from middle school through graduate school and boosting student enrollment in Advanced Placement (AP) science programs.



STUDENT STORIES

Groundbreaking Research

Distinguished professor of biology Kamaljit Bawa has been at the forefront of groundbreaking biology and climate change research for five decades. The evolutionary ecologist and conservation biologist was among the first researchers to consider the role of sexual selection in the evolution of plant breeding systems and to use DNA sequences to study the genetic makeup of tropical forest trees.

"One dreams of getting such a recognition, but really do[es] not expect much in reality, as there are a very large number of people out there doing extraordinary work," Bawa says.

The center—which has received more than \$600 million in funding—includes seven academic medical institutions and schools and has a team of more than 1,000 cancer researchers.


